The food co-op is open 51 weeks per year for weekly shopping. Annually, the students need at least 3,000 pounds of ground beef, 4,500 gallons of milk, 40,000 pounds of fresh fruits and vegetables, and 2,500 dozen eggs. It is a blessing to have packages of cheese and fruit juice. The grant money will be used to purchase perishable food items, either from suppliers that deliver such as the dairy and produce wholesaler or from local grocery stores and the local food bank. In serving the students who are preparing for service to God, they too are being cared for.

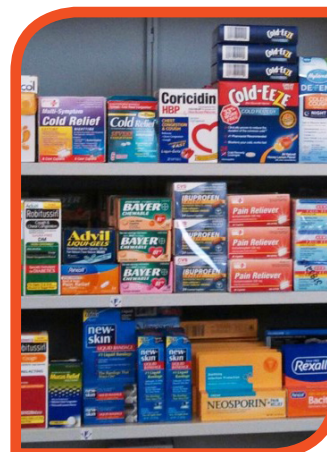
