QUALIFICATIONS:

- Any mature young woman, approximately 22-40 years of age, who is a member of the LCMS
- Has not previously attended a national convention as a YWR
- Has a deep love and devotion for her Lord Jesus Christ
- Is able and willing to participate in the full scope of the convention
- Completes the application legibly, thoroughly and honestly and submits it by the deadline
- Is able to be away from home/work/children for the entire convention and the travel time involved

EXPECTATIONS:

- Serve on the Young Women's Committee for at least 2 years following attendance at the national convention
- Attend all sessions of the convention and special events planned for YWRs, sitting as assigned with the district delegation, though not eligible to vote
- Keep an accurate and detailed record of her expenses with receipts and submit a voucher for reimbursement. LWML SWD will pay for registration, meals and mileage to the convention.
- Be available to share her YWR experience with groups/zones within the district
